

2017 Ride The Rockies Bicycle Tour Presented by ViaWest



Registration

Lottery applications will be accepted February 5-26. All applicants will be notified of their standing on March 3. If selected, registrations are non-transferable and cards will be charged the full entry fee of \$495, plus any products purchased and/or donations made during the application process. Ride The Rockies registrations are lottery based and the Tour is capped at 2,000 participants.

Prologue:

Bypass the lottery by signing up for the Prologue, a two-day “wine and dine” experience limited to the first 50 riders to register.

Team Entries:

Friends or family can apply as a team up to ten people. Riders can sign up simultaneously (on one computer) and/or add members to the team through February 26. A team Captain is required to create an account and team name; which he or she will then share with other members so that they may find and join that team. The team name will be entered into the lottery and if the team is selected, everyone on that team will be accepted. Riders under the age of 18 need to be accompanied by an adult over 21 and should also apply as a team.

Items Included in Registration:

RTR welcome package, camping space, showers, transportation of one bag for the entire week (up to 70 lbs.), shuttle services within host communities, entertainment in host communities, aid stations, bike techs, SAG vehicles, medical support, commemorative jersey, water bottle, tour mapbook and event ap.

Transportation

Shuttles:

A shuttle service will be providing transportation for cyclists to the start host community and to end destinations from the finish community. Reservations are required and will be accepted beginning March 6.

Bicycle Shipping:

BikeFlights.com's flexible bicycle shipping service makes it easy to find rates, create shipment labels which you can attach to your bike box/case and they can pick it up at your door. Their team monitors your shipment, informs you of the status and ready for assembly at the start. During the event, they'll store your box/case and have it for you at the finish.

Accommodations

Camping:

Indoor and outdoor camping is provided free of charge. Indoor accommodations are traditionally held in a school gymnasium. Riders must provide their own camping gear.

Sherpa Packer Too LLC.– Valet Camping:

A full service tent set-up and transportation service is available during the Tour by The Sherpa Packer Too LLC for an additional charge.

Hotels, Motels & B&B's:

On March 6 participants may submit hotel requests online. Requests are handled on a first come, first serve basis. More information will be provided if you are accepted into the lottery.
